Dear Ms. Brantl:

On March 15, 2011, Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc., and Global Crossing Local Services ("Applicants") filed an application seeking to amend certain debt financing arrangements previously approved by the Georgia Public Service Commission ("Commission"). The Applicants requested and received approval to provide security in connection with financing up to \$1 billion being arranged for their affiliated Parent and Holdings companies. Applicants have offered Senior Notes due in 2015 in the aggregate principle amount of \$650 million with an interest rate of LIBOR (London Inter-Bank Offered Rate) plus points and up to \$350 million in the form of conventional revolving credit facilities. Applicants are seeking to increase the aggregate amount by \$700 million and will continue to grant a security interest in their assets and their capital stock or membership. The senior secured credit proceeds are anticipated to fund working capital and other general corporate purposes, including debt repurchases and possibly the acquisition of the other telecommunications companies and/or telecommunications assets. The transaction will be transparent to customers and not have any adverse impact.

The Applicants are certified in Georgia to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services competitive local exchange services, alternate operator services and interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to certificates of authority numbers R-028, and L-070.

During its Administrative Session of April 5, 2011, the Commission considered the above-referenced item and found it to be reasonable and proper. The Commission

also found that it was appropriate without the need for a hearing in this matter. Approval of this transaction is expressly based on the representation contained in the application filed on March 15, 2011. The Commission reserves the right to later revisit this matter and issue any further orders as it may deem necessary.

ORDERED, that an application of Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. and Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., for Approval to amend Certain Financial Arrangements as in the body of this order is hereby approved. described

ORDERED FURTHER, that the authority granted herein is contingent upon the approval of any other regulatory body having jurisdiction over this matter.


ORDERED FURTHER, that within 30 days of completion of the financing transaction, the Company shall file a full and complete report on the final disposition.

ORDERED FURTHER, that the Commission hereby waives a hearing in this matter.

ORDERED FURTHER, that jurisdiction over this matter is expressly retained for the purpose of entering such further order or orders, as this Commission may deem just and proper.

ORDERED FURTHER, that a motion for reconsideration, rehearing, or oral argument or any other motion shall not stay the effective date of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.
