The Georgia Public Service Commission ("Commission"), by Order dated June 28, 2012 in Docket No. 35277, approved a Supplemental Stipulation between the Association for Fairness in Ratemaking ("AFFIRM"), the Georgia Public Service Commission Public Interest Advocacy Staff ("Staff"), and Georgia Power Company ("GPC" or "Company"). Pursuant to that Order and Supplemental Stipulation, which required development of a multi-part time-of-use pilot program, the Company filed a Three Part Time-of-Use Fuel Cost Recovery ("TOU-FCR-TP-1") Pilot Program on August 15, 2012. The Order further required the program to be presented for Commission consideration by August 30, 2012.

The TOU-FCR-TP-1 pilot program has been designed to be revenue neutral to the FCR tariff and will:

- Consist of up to one thousand (1,000) voluntary participants who currently receive service under either the TOU-MB or TOU-PEV rate schedules.
- Be a three-part TOU fuel rate, with defined time periods and pricing corresponding to the base rate tariff.
- Begin October 1, 2012 and run through September 30, 2013.
- Be evaluated after one year's worth of data is collected and prior to the next FCR proceeding.

The rate schedule will be available to eligible customers through September 30, 2013. Any customer who has volunteered for this pilot program before September 30, 2013 will be allowed to continue service under the tariff until rates are reset in the FCR-24 case.

Staff reviewed the Company's filing and recommended Commission approval. The Commission hereby approves Georgia Power's Three Part Time-of-Use Fuel Cost Recovery Pilot Program.


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WHEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that Georgia Power Company's Three Part Time-of-Use Pilot Program is hereby approved.


ORDERED FURTHER, that jurisdiction over this matter is expressly retained for the purpose of entering such further Order or Orders as this Commission may deem just and proper.
