ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

On August 2, 2016, the Georgia Public Service Commission" Commission" issued an Order Adopting Stipulations ("Order") in the above-referenced Dockets. The Order contained an inadvertent inconsistency related to the Commission's determination for new nuclear generation.

In the body of the Order, the Commission found and concluded, that the 'Company's asfiled request on this issue shall be modified so that the Company is allowed to record through the end of the second calendar quarter of 2019 up to \$99 million for activities as identified earlier in the section of this order relating to the investigation of pursuing new nuclear generation option at the site in Stewart County." (Order p. 8)

However, the second Ordering Paragraph in the Order states that "Georgia Power Company authorized to <u>spend</u> up to \$99 million <u>between now and the ending</u> of the second calendar quarter of 2019 to investigate the option of pursuing new nuclear generation as a potential future base-load option at a site in Stewart County, Georgia." (Order p. 12, Second Ordering Paragraph)

The Commission finds and concludes that the Second Ordering paragraph is hereby corrected and shall directly mirror the language referenced in the body of the Order at p.8, last sentence in the third full paragraph referenced above.

* * * * * *

WHEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that the Second Ordering paragraph is hereby corrected and shall read as follows:

ORDERED FURTHER, that Georgia Power Company's as-filed request on this issue [of preserving the option for new nuclear generation] shall be modified so that the Company is allowed to record through the end of the second calendar quarter of 2019 up to \$99 million for activities as identified earlier in the section of this order relating to the investigation of pursuing new nuclear generation option at the site in Stewart County.

ORDERED FURTHER, all findings, conclusions, and decisions contained within the preceding sections of this Order are hereby adopted as findings of fact, conclusions of law, and decisions of regulatory policy of this Commission.

ORDERED FURTHER, except as expressly corrected herein, all other provisions of the Commission's August 2, 2016, Order shall remain in full force and effect.

ORDERED FURTHER, any motion for reconsideration, rehearing or oral argument, or any other motion shall not stay the effective date of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission.

ORDERED FURTHER, jurisdiction over this matter is expressly retained for the purpose of entering such further Order or Orders as this Commission may deem just and proper.
