**ORDER APPROVING CHANGE OF CONTROL REGARDING THE TWIGGS
COUNTY, LLC SOLAR FACILITY**

On January 29, 2018, the Georgia Public Service Commission ("Commission") approved an executed Renewable Energy Development Initiative ("REDI") Utility Scale Solar Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA") between Georgia Power Company ("Georgia Power" or "Company") and Twiggs County Solar, LLC ("Twiggs County Solar"). The approved PPA is for thirty (30) years of energy, capacity, and the related renewable energy credits ("RECs") from a 200 MW solar facility, located in Dry Branch, Georgia, beginning on December 31, 2019.

On August 9, 2018, the Commission issued an order in this docket approving a Change of Control and Delegation of Operational Responsibility for the Twiggs County Solar facility wherein First Solar Development, LLC ("FSD") underwent transactions with Origis Holdings USA, Inc, ("Origis"), pursuant to which Origis acquired one hundred percent (100%) of the issued and outstanding limited liability company membership interests in Twiggs County Solar.

Origis entered into a Membership Interest Purchase Agreement dated September 21, 2018 with HDSTY 2017-1 LLC ("Global"), pursuant to which Origis will cause its subsidiary, Origis Pipeline Funding IV, LLC, to sell, and Global will acquire one hundred percent (100%) of the issued and outstanding limited liability company membership interests in GA Solar 4, LLC, (the upstream owner of Twiggs County Solar). After consummation of the Change of Control transaction, the operation and maintenance services with respect to the facility will continue to be performed by Origis Technics USA, Inc., a wholly-owned affiliate of Origis.

Georgia Power has negotiated the appropriate documents to provide Georgia Power's consent to the Change of Control transaction ("Consent"). On February 7, 2019, Georgia Power filed a petition with the Commission requesting approval of the Change of Control transaction. Copies of the Consent were provided to the Commission Staff ("Staff"). After its review, Staff recommended approval of the Twiggs County Solar Change of Control transaction.

The Commission adopted Staff's recommendation at the February 19th, 2019 Administrative Session.


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WHEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that Georgia Power Company's request for approval of the Change of Control transaction between Origis Pipeline Funding IV, LLC and HDSTY 2017-1 LLC concerning the Twiggs County Solar, LLC solar facility is hereby approved.

ORDERED FURTHER, that a motion for reconsideration, rehearing, or oral argument or any other motion shall not stay the effective date of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED FURTHER, that jurisdiction over this matter is expressly retained for the purpose of entering such further Order or Orders as this Commission may deem just and proper.
