ORDER ON ATLANTA LIGHT COMPANY'S NOTICE OF REVISION TO PEAKING SERVICE (PS) RATE TO BE EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2020

This matter comes before the Georgia Public Service Commission ("Commission") as a result of Atlanta Gas Light Company's ("AGL") filing with the Commission regarding the proposed change to its PS Rate for the Atlanta Pool and Macon Pool. AGL is proposing the change take effect on May 1, 2020, in accordance with Commission Rule 515-3-1-.07.

BACKGROUND:

On March 26, 2020, AGL filed the Company's Notice of Revision to Peaking Service (PS) Rate with a proposed effective date of May 1, 2020.

The Commission's September 30, 2019 Order Adopting the Stipulation in Docket 42317 required that AGL and the Certificated Marketers discuss the movement of customer accounts currently in the Rome and Ex-ATL-SNG pool groups into the Atlanta Pool group during the 2019-2020 heating season. As a result of these adjustments, 119,107 customer accounts will be impacted. Out of the 119,107 accounts, 113,779 will be moving into the Atlanta Pool; and 5,328 Atlanta customer accounts will be moving to the Macon Pool, as shown in the table below.

The PS rate will apply to those 113,779 customer accounts moved to the Atlanta Pool, since they will be receiving the service provided by the Atlanta Pool's Liquefied Natural Gas ("LNG") facilities. The 5,328 customers moving from the Atlanta Pool to the Macon Pool will have no change in their ability to receive service from an LNG facility and thus, will continue to pay the PS charge.

The Certificated Marketers requested that AGL lower the PS charge for those customers in Atlanta Pool since more customers will be assessed the peaking service charge. Staff supported this request. Therefore, AGL proposed to lower the PS rate for the customers in the Atlanta Pool to \$0.96/DDDC, to be effective May 1, 2020. As part of the petition, AGL provided the re-calculation which supports the revised PS Rate, attached as Exhibit A. The proposed new Rate Schedule showing the proposed changes to be made to the PS Rate, along with a clean version of the same are attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Staff has been part of the discussions regarding this change, has reviewed the petition with the accompanying Exhibits, and has verified the calculations. Therefore, Staff recommends approval.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The Commission finds and concludes that the revised tariff modification as provided herein as Exhibit B is a fair and reasonable resolution of this matter. Therefore, the Commission approves and adopts the revised PS rate.

* * * * *

WHEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that the Commission hereby approves the revised tariff modification as shown in Exhibit B with an effective date of May 1, 2020.

ORDERED FURTHER that a motion for reconsideration, rehearing or oral argument or any other motion shall not stay the effective date of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED FURTHER, that jurisdiction over this matter is expressly retained for the purpose of entering such further Order or Orders, as this Commission may deem just and proper.


