The Protected Information derives economic value from not being generally known and from not being readily ascertainable by proper means and is the subject of efforts by NextEra Energy Services that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy. As such, and for the reasons stated below, the Protected Information constitutes trade secret information as defined by O.C.G.A. § 10-1-761(4) and is therefore protected from disclosure under Commission Rule 515-3-1-.11.

The natural gas market in Georgia is highly competitive, growing rapidly, and there are numerous marketers that offer the same services as NextEra Energy Services. The Protected Information includes confidential financial data and the negotiated terms of NextEra Energy Services acquisition of Fireside Natural Gas, LLC, which are not commonly known by NextEra Energy Services’ competitors, nor readily ascertainable through proper means by such competitors. In fact, to ensure the confidentiality of the Protected Information, only selected personnel have access to it. Before NextEra Energy Services would grant access to the Protected

Information to a party outside of NextEra Energy Services, its affiliates, or its legal counsel, NextEra Energy Services would require the party to sign a confidentiality agreement. Indeed, it would competitively and unfairly disadvantage NextEra Energy Services and ultimately NextEra Energy Services' customers if the Protected Information became available to competitors.

More specifically, the Protected Information includes detailed descriptions of NextEra Energy Services financial revenues. These documents also include confidential information regarding debt, credit facilities, and customer information. Thus, disclosure of the Protected Information would give insight to competitors and third-party vendors with respect to NextEra Energy Services' financial resources and/or marketing plans, as well as its future strategies regarding the natural gas market in Georgia. With such information, competitors and third-party vendors could unfairly benefit economically by implementing proactive strategies in a manner that would harm NextEra Energy Services. Moreover, because the Protected Information itself has been developed through the expenditure of significant resources, to allow competitors to access it without similarly expending such resources would also grant them an unfair economic advantage to the economic detriment of NextEra Energy Services.

For all the foregoing reasons, NextEra Energy Services has submitted the Protected Information to the Commission under protective seal with the designation "TRADE SECRET" prominently displayed on each page thereof. NextEra Energy Services has also filed a "Public Disclosure" version with the designation "PUBLIC DISCLOSURE DOCUMENT" prominently displayed on each page. NextEra Energy Services will maintain a master list of all filings submitted to the Commission pursuant to Commission Rule 515-3-1-.11 governing trade secrets. The master list will identify the documents submitted, the number of copies submitted, and the docket number related to NextEra Energy Services' filing.




